AIGA-Atlanta's Student Board has established a series of scholarships for Atlanta-area graphic design students. These scholarships will award funds to cover membership fees for one year, at the rate of your next membership renewal level. Students who are not currently AIGA members may also apply, and winners will similarly be awarded funds to cover membership fees for one year.

Criteria for this scholarship includes:

- Current status as an AIGA student member, or current enrollment in an Atlanta metro-area Graphic Design degree or graduate certificate program
- An essay (no longer than one page) describing what you've done with AIGA-Atlanta over the past year: volunteering or attending events, taking part in student chapter activities, etc. What have you learned from these experiences, and how do you hope to continue being an active member of AIGA in the next year? For non-member applicants, what do you hope to learn from becoming an active member of AIGA? How do you plan to give back to the community (through volunteering, becoming an active member of your student chapter, etc.)
- A PDF of three to five examples of your work
- At the end of the year, scholarship winners will be required to submit a report describing their activity with AIGA, and how it has benefited them.

A total of 10 scholarships will be awarded each year: 5 in March and 5 in September (see deadlines below). Applications must be received by 5:00pm **Friday, February 29, 2008**; the scholarships will be awarded at the first Student Board meeting following each application deadline, and winners will be notified by e-mail. A student may only receive this scholarship once, regardless of amount of scholarship.
